



Signature Talk: "Proactive and Reactive Parenting"

Based on *Unison Parenting*

Cecil draws from the first two chapters of *Unison Parenting* to lay a foundation for parents.

- Proactive Parenting is planning a structured policy for how you are going to parent, then implementing it. The parents agree on core values, a framework for behavior, and policies which implement, monitor, and reward or assign consequences for child behaviors. This is steady-state parenting.
- Reactive Parenting addresses when life throws a curve. Cecil shares a model for how parents can remain unified when dealing with the unexpected and the confusing.

Parents should come away with the basics for setting a family framework and some key introductory points for staying in unison.



Cecil dives into one of the book’s key chapters, called “Relinquishing Certainty, Embracing Uncertainty.” Perhaps our greatest issue in leaving comfort zones is relinquishing certainty. Jesus never promises the kind of certainty we crave, yet we’re always struggling to attain certainty in this life.

As Hebrews 11:1 states, “Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.” Cecil builds the case that uncertainty is indeed the soil in which faith grows; therefore, to grow our faith, we must embrace and even seek out uncertainty.



In this talk, Cecil discusses how to emulate trees in caring for the human forest.


Participants will take away concepts of kindness and vulnerability that enhance human forest relationships.
