These are designed to introduce participants to useful, actionable concepts without overwhelming information. Cecil adds "beyond the book" content to the presentation. Signature talks consume one hour but can be scaled to your needs, such as retreats.

"Uncertainty is the Soil in which Faith Grows"

Based on From Comfort Zone to Trust Zone, Cecil dives into and adds to one of the book's key chapters, called "Relinquishing Certainty, Embracing Uncertainty." Perhaps our greatest issue in leaving comfort zones is relinquishing certainty. Jesus never promises the kind of certainty we crave, yet we're always struggling to attain certainty in this life.

As Hebrews 11:1 states, "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." Cecil builds the case that uncertainty is indeed the soil in which faith grows; therefore, to grow our faith, we must embrace and even seek out uncertainty.

Participants will take away a pattern for being open to uncertainty and risk for Christ's sake.

"Setting a Family Context and Culture"

Cecil draws from the first two chapters of **Unison Parenting** to lay a family culture foundation for all parents, teaching proactive and reactive parenting.

- Proactive Parenting is planning a structured policy for how you are going to parent, then implementing it. The parents agree on core values, a framework for behavior, and policies which implement, monitor, and reward or assign consequences for child behaviors. This is steady-state parenting.
- Reactive Parenting addresses when life throws a curve. Cecil shares a model for how parents can remain unified when dealing with the unexpected and the confusing.

Parents should come away with the basics for setting a family framework and some key introductory points for staying in unison as parents and as a family.

"Partnering with Your Teen for Safety"

In this straight-talk **Unison Parenting** session for families with teens, Cecil suggests ways to protect your teens from trouble even as you send them out into the world. He shares 11 ways to prevent such issues.

Cecil then introduces a basic three-part framework for being attentive to teen situations and how to follow up on the preventative practices you've established.

Parents should come away with tactical ways to collaborate with their teens for both growth and safety.

More Signature Talks

"Accepting the Crisis"

Cecil draws from and adds to *The Next Thing* to discuss a key first step in dealing with crisis in personal life. One of our inclinations when a crisis occurs is to deny that it's happening. But we cannot effectively address the crisis until we accept the crisis.

Acceptance doesn't mean we're "OK" with what has happened. Instead, acceptance is engaging with the reality of the crisis, then adapting, coping, and responding skillfully to that reality.

Participants will be equipped to move from the stuck place of denial to the active stance of addressing the crisis with unique techniques and mindset.

"Living in the Freedom and Immediacy of God's Love"

Echoing his book *Live Like You're Loved*, Cecil shares the powerful concept that your life can be transformed quickly when you accept God's love. This day, you can experience love, forgiveness, being sent with purpose, and a close walk with God that stretches into eternity. Yes, full healing of wounds takes time, but transformation can begin.

Cecil explores how God's immediacy is present via the Holy Spirit, and how God's freedom looks different from what we might expect.

Participants will learn steps to transform their lives and what it looks like to live a transformed life.

"Caring for the Human Forest"

Did you know that trees take care of each other? Using an underground mychorrizal network, trees can shuttle nutrients and even "messages" to each other. The legacy trees are the most mature trees and tend to the others. The entire forest benefits when trees care for each other.

In this talk based on *The Legacy Tree* video series, Cecil discusses how to use the model of the trees in caring for our neighbors in the human forest.

Participants will take away concepts of kindness and vulnerability that enhance human relationships.
